

International MBA Scholarship Guidelines

1. Purpose:

The International MBA Scholarship is an award to incoming IMBA local students in recognition of their previous academic excellence and to current students for their academic excellence and devoted service to the program.

2. Availability of Scholarship:

- For incoming IMBA local students, the IMBA program will award scholarships based on budgetary considerations.
- For current IMBA students, seven scholarships are available to qualified students.

3. Scholarship Amount:

- The IMBA Scholarship will award each incoming local student the amount of up to NT200,000 tuition waiver that must be used within one academic year.
- For current IMBA students, the scholarships are NT\$200,000 tuition waiver for one recipient, and NTD100,000 tuition waiver for six recipients that must be used within one academic year.

4. Qualifications:

Eligible students are:

- A. Incoming local students who have not received a scholarship to attend the program are eligible.
- B. Current students who have not received a scholarship to attend the program, not including IMBA scholarship.

5. Process:

- Incoming local students: On merit-based. No application is required.
 - Current IMBA students will be evaluated based on their academic performance and devotion to the program over the past academic year. No formal application, IMBA Program will award qualified students.
6. Students who are awarded the scholarship and defer their study at the IMBA program will be disqualified for scholarship award.
 7. Any modification of the Guidelines must be approved by IMBA Committee.
 8. The Guidelines take effect upon announcement.
